The Arts Building, 808 Lincoln Way, Auburn. The encaustic technique will be presented by local artist, Janet Joslin.

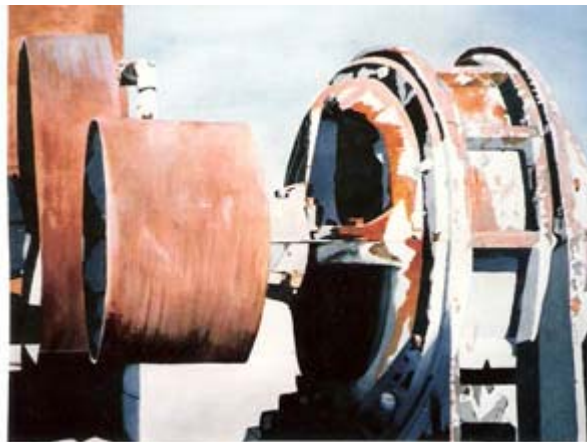
Janet, essentially self-taught, is skilled in a variety of mediums such as silk dye, watercolor, oils, acrylic, pastel, ceramics and with heated beeswax which is called encaustic painting. She chooses the medium she feels will provide the best means of aesthetic expression for the chosen subject. Noted primarily for her dramatic floral paintings, Janet has recently completed a series in which her usual intense and deeply saturated colors have given way to a softly diffused, more neutral palette. To achieve this look, she has been exploiting the properties of encaustic.

Janet maintains a studio/gallery in Newcastle, California at 450 Main Street across from the Newcastle Produce Market, where she now devotes herself to full time painting and teaching.
